

Why Sage Homes Installs Automatically Controlled Humidifiers

You may be familiar with the manual humidifier control which is likely sitting on your wall – right next to the furnace thermostat. That dial controls the amount of humidity in your home. The humidifier needs you to constantly adjust the proper humidity in your house, based on the temperature outside. Forget to adjust it down during a cold snap – and BAM! – you have thick ice all over the bottom of your windows. Conversely, forget to turn it up during a warming spell, and your woodwork suddenly starts showing cracks from a lack of humidity in the house, and the family starts to experience nosebleeds.

The solution is to let the Aprilaire Automatic Control Panel take care of the adjustments. We install this digital panel near the furnace, and we install a small temperature probe outside. The Automatic Panel monitors the outdoor temperature, and adjusts the humidity level automatically to create the best environment for the inside of your home, based on calibration.

The Automatic Panels can be retrofit onto your existing Aprilaire 600 or 700 model installations, or a complete new humidifier unit can be installed on most furnace configurations.

Digital Control provides accurate information and automatically delivers proper humidity levels continually; regardless of temperature or conditions.



1. Know your relative humidity.
2. Know when your system is running.
3. Know when to replace the water panel. (*Evaporative only*)
4. Know immediately when service is needed.
5. Turn on the HVAC blower for humidification
